



The 5th International Conference on Investigative Interviewing will be held at the École nationale de police du Québec (350, rue Marguerite-D'Youville, Nicolet (Quebec), Canada, J3T 1X4).

This Conference on “Adapting to new realities” will be held September 9-12, 2012.

The following topics will be addressed: suspects, witnesses and victims interviews, verbal communication, lie detection, financial crimes, teaching interviewing techniques and new research in investigative interviews.

We also wish to receive presentation proposals regarding new realities like the impact of interviews available on the Internet, corruption, hate crimes, changes in the Code of practice and other new issues. A call for papers is now open and we invite you to submit proposals of presentations.
